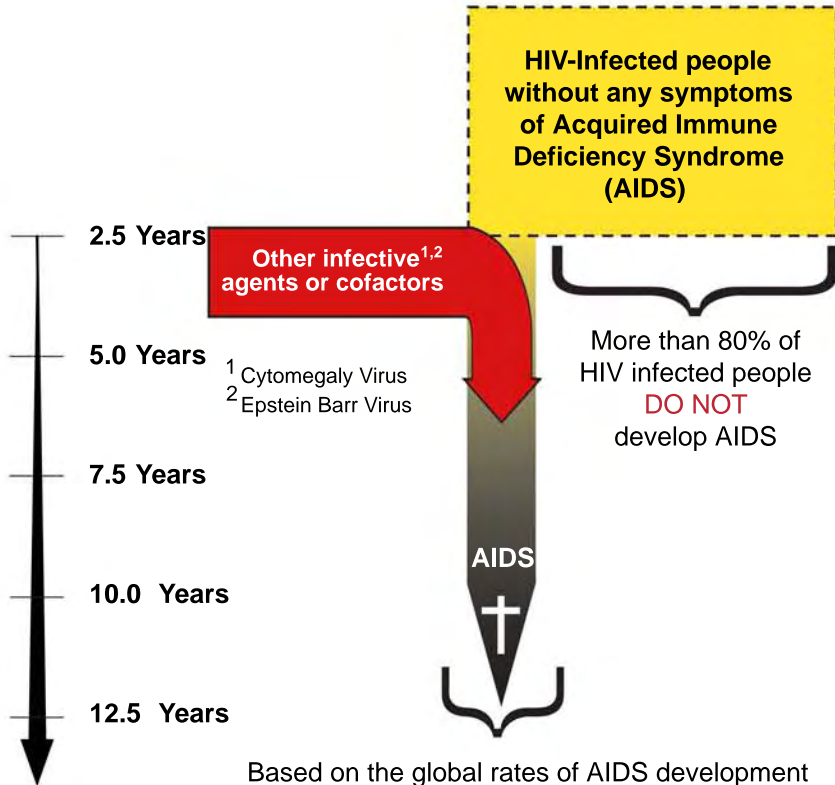


# AIDS Development and Mortality Rates in HIV-Positive Persons

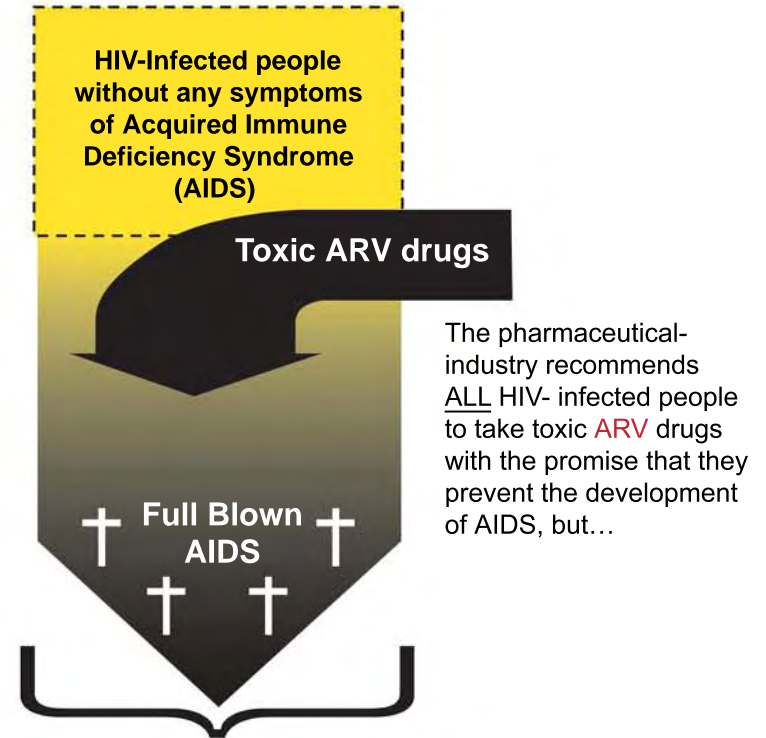
- Based on Global Data\* -



Based on the global rates of AIDS development in HIV-positive people, less than 20% of them develop AIDS within 13 years

\* The data used are based on global AIDS cases from WHO reports in 2001.

- Based on ARV drug studies\*\* -



The pharmaceutical-industry recommends ALL HIV- infected people to take toxic ARV drugs with the promise that they prevent the development of AIDS, but...

...based on the mortality rate of HIV-positiv patients\*\* treated with ARV drugs, it can be calculated that all patients would develop full blown AIDS and die from it in less than 13 years.

**HIV-positive people on ARV drugs have a 4 to 6 times higher chance of dying from AIDS.**
