

THE CAMPAIGN FOR EQUALITY FOR NATURAL THERAPIES

- 1.** The British Medical Journal should pledge to dedicate in all future editions an equal amount of space to scientific and medical reports from the field of micronutrient research and other science-based natural health approaches as it does to medical reports about patented drugs.
- 2.** In order to ensure that pharmaceutically-oriented medicine and science-based natural health research are represented equally in the British Medical Journal, the Editorial Board of the BMJ should appoint an equal number of new board members selected from scientists with an expertise in science-based natural health research.
- 3.** The BMJ should launch a “Young Researcher Award in Science-Based Natural Health” in 2007. This prize should be awarded annually with prize money of no less than £50,000, to ensure the growing interest and participation in natural health research of future generations of doctors and scientists.
